  - Brewed coffee or a selection of teas are also included in your evening.

## Commonly asked questions:

- **What about seating for dinner?** - the dining room on the lower deck is shared booth seating and commonly you will be seated with other guests. We find this a great social environment to meet people while on holidays. Should you wish to have a table on your own please see the "Upgrade Options" below.
- **What do I wear?** - we encourage guests to wear smart casual, with a jacket recommended in winter months.
  - We ask for ladies to please not wear shoes that have high heels.**
- **What about drinks?** - we have full bar facilities and a selection of fine wines for purchase.
- **Is it always calm?** - due to the many islands and inlets close to Hamilton Island we will always stop for dinner at a calm, secluded spot - guaranteed!
- **Where do we go?** - generally we visit the largest and most protected harbour in the Whitsundays called Cid Harbour. If the weather is very windy we also have options very close to Hamilton Island.
- **Days and times of operation?** - please check when booking as these depend on the time of year.
