On the Edge is a large, spacious sailing catamaran designed especially for day sailing adventures throughout the Whitsunday Islands. She is 20m long x 12m wide & offers the largest deck area per guest of any vessel operating day excursions from Hamilton Island.

A day sailing On the Edge will provide you with an exhilarating sailing adventure and the ultimate Whitsunday experience.

Included in your day is a visit to Whitehaven Beach and a separate location for snorkelling – usually Chalkies Beach or Border Island (pending weather).

We have special Marine Park Permits that allow us choice to visit the best snorkelling site on the day pending weather conditions.

Your day out includes morning/afternoon tea and lunch served on board whilst anchored at one of the destinations. There is also a fully stocked bar on board to enjoy a glass of wine over lunch or a cleansing ale whilst sailing home.

On the Edge has cover to protect from the elements and large forward decks providing ample space to lie back and enjoy sailing the Whitsundays in style and comfort.

Included in your day cruise On the Edge

- A full day sailing from approximately 9.00am through to 4.00pm but confirm these times when booking.
- A visit to Whitehaven Beach and a separate location for snorkelling – usually Chalkies Beach or Border Island pending conditions.
- Morning/afternoon tea and build your own sandwich buffet lunch including prawns, cold meats and a variety of salad.

We also have cordial for the kids.

- All snorkelling equipment including wetsuit/stinger suits and floatation jackets if required.
- Comprehensive snorkel and safety briefing and personalised instruction if required.
- Informative commentary throughout the day on the local history, fauna and flora.
- Weather proof jackets if required are on board.

Commonly asked questions:

What should I bring? – you will need a hat, towel & sunscreen. We also ask flat soled shoes if possible and also limit your baggage to one backpack per couple please.

Are there drinks available? – we have a fully stocked bar on board. Cash, credit card or room charge is available.

What about shade? – the special design of vessel has a roof that covers a large portion of guests at all times and we also have additional shade awnings for when eating lunch.

How many people on board? – as On the Edge is such a spacious catamaran she can operate with up to 60 passengers at one time.

We generally will operate the day tour with 50 guests max.

What about the weather? – we live and sail in the tropics all year round and at times the weather is unpredictable. Before departure we will provide you with an up to date weather report for the day and discuss in detail with you the scheduled plan for the day.

Days of operation? – check when booking but we generally operate at least six days per week.

Is this cruise for all ages? – being a sailing cat the vessel is generally very stable. We do however recommend children be five years and above for this tour.
