Vessel Information

On the Edge is a large 20m long by 12m wide sailing catamaran especially designed for day sailing throughout the Whitsunday Islands. She has the largest deck space per guest of any vessel operating from Hamilton Island and combines exhilarating sailing with a large stable platform. The capacity of On the Edge is 55 guests and five crew.

In the following document you will find all the information you need to charter On the Edge for your group. When chartering On the Edge the time of day of your charter and the length of time you would like to be on the water, will determine which style of cruise is best for you.

A highly desirable destination to celebrate your wedding day is the world famous Whitehaven Beach and Hill Inlet. Both of these destinations are available when chartering On the Edge for either your actual wedding ceremony or pre/post wedding celebration.

If considering Whitehaven Beach we ask that you keep in mind a couple of very important factors. Firstly, everything we do in relation to Whitehaven Beach is subject to the weather and secondly without stating the obvious your celebration is on a boat. As such, there are quite a few parts of the day that are different to a normal wedding day and we ask that you ensure you read these items later in this portfolio.

The vessel is designed especially for day sailing throughout the Whitsunday Islands. She does have a roof that provides cover from the elements over approximately 50% of the vessel pending group size. We look forward to welcoming you aboard On the Edge for your unique sailing wedding celebration.

Reef Levy Explanation – Day charters with a stop over visiting a beach is \$7.50pp, No stop over is \$6 pp
Sunset Charters or charters less than 3 hours duration is \$3 pp.

Cruise Detail and Explanations for On the Edge

Full Day Sail & Whitehaven Beach

- ☞ The duration permitted of a day charter is seven hours, returning to Hamilton Island by 4pm.
- ☞ We generally visit two destinations for a full day charter. One destination for snorkelling pending conditions on the day and Whitehaven Beach as the second. The destination on the day is weather dependant. The destinations visited on the day are flexible.
- ☞ Lunch is included in the full day charter rate. BBQ upgrades for lunch including a chef are also available.
- ☞ Snorkelling equipment including wet suits or lycra suits are included in all day charters.
- ☞ All guests are transported to and from the beach using the vessel tender which carries 10 passengers at a time. When disembarking at the beach you will generally have to wade through water that is up to your shins so long pants, dresses and high heels are not suitable.
- ☞ Wind limits of being able to have a reasonably comfortable sail to Whitehaven Beach is 20 knots. On the Edge is a large stable platform and we have a number of alternate destinations available on the day should conditions not suit. A unique feature of the Whitsunday Islands is the various calm sailing options available should we need to change destinations.
- ☞ Should Hill Inlet be a desired destination our passenger limitation under National Parks Legislation is 35 people. We have a special Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Permit that allows us to use sections of Whitehaven Beach that others cannot. Hamilton Island Weddings is also the only operator in the Whitsundays with the proper legislative compliance permits for weddings to be performed on Whitehaven Beach.
- ☞ Reef levy is \$7.50 per person for full day charters.

Part Day Sail

- ☞ Generally four hours is what we classify as a part day sail however it is available for a maximum of 5 hours with an additional charge applying for the extra hour.
- ☞ We ask that half day cruises return to Hamilton Island no later than 4pm. Should this timing not suit your requirements the anytime charter rate would apply.
- ☞ Time limits prevail that only one destination is available on the half day sail. A minimum of 5 hours is required to visit Whitehaven Beach or to Border Island for snorkelling
- ☞ Lunch is included in the half day charter rate with BBQ upgrades including a chef available.
- ☞ Snorkelling equipment including wet suits or lycra suits are included in all day charters.
- ☞ Reef levy is \$7.50pp if visiting Whitehaven Beach for half day charters or \$5.50 pp if no beach visit and snorkelling only.

Anytime of Day Sail

- ☞ This charter is designed to depart Hamilton Island after 11am and return just after sunset.
- ☞ This style of charter is available for up to 8 hours with timing of the day flexible around the eight hour parameter. An additional hour is available with additional costs applying.
- ☞ The cruise must return to Hamilton Island no later than sunset which will be determined by the time of year and the departure time of the trip.
- ☞ Lunch is included in the price of the charter with a BBQ upgrade including a chef also available.
- ☞ Snorkelling is available and option dependant on the duration of the charter.

Sunset Sail

- ☞ The normal duration of this cruise is one and a half hours. Additional time is available up to a maximum of 2.5 hours with additional charges applying for the vessel and beverages.
- ☞ Departure times will vary throughout the year and depend on the time of the sunset. Generally it is 4.30pm onwards in Winter months and 5.30pm onwards in Summer months.
- ☞ A light nibbles platter is included in the sunset charter rate.
- ☞ Beverages of beer, wine, champagne and soft drink is also included in the charter rate for Sunset Cruises. An upgraded beverage package from our standard beverages is also available



Catering Options for On the Edge

Included in the day sail, part day sail or anytime of the day sail.

Morning tea is served upon boarding comprising of coffee, selection of teas and cordial. Also available will be a biscuit and sweet muffin selection.

Lunch as build your own focaccia rolls or wraps with the following ;

- Leg ham/ Roast chicken / Beef
- Sliced Tomato
- Cheese, Cucumber
- Red onion, Grated carrot
- Lettuce or English Spinach
- Condiments

Large cooked Gold Coast tiger prawns are also included – just peel and eat.

Afternoon tea including a tropical fresh fruit platter of whatever product is available at that time of the year

BBQ Lunch Upgrade - Additional \$12.50 pp

Children (5-14yrs) Additional 7.50 pp

Morning tea Served upon boarding comprising of coffee, a selection of teas and cordial. Also available will be a biscuit and muffin selection.

Beverage Options for On the Edge

On the Edge is a fully licenced venue and as such we do not permit BYO beverages. We generally have two styles beer, white wine, red wine, champagne, UDL's and assorted softdrinks.

Day Cruise

As our day cruise generally involves snorkelling and is up to seven hours we do not offer beverage packages or include beverages in any pricing. There is tea/coffee and cordial included throughout the day with beverage charges on consumption.

Sunset Cruise

Our Sunset Cruise is inclusive of beverages for the duration of the 90 minute cruise. An indication of our standard beverages included are as follows:

- Pure Blond and XXXX Gold – Australian Beers, White Wine – Benchmark SSB
- Red Wine – Benchmark Shiraz
- Champagne

This selection may be slightly different on the day of the cruise. If the sunset cruise duration longer than 90 minutes additional charges will apply at \$7.50 per person per 30 minute interval for the beverage portion of the cruise.

Upgrading the quality of beers and wine is available upon request and additional charges will apply.

Of course with any service of alcohol we adhere to Responsible Service of Alcohol practices and will refuse service to any passenger we deem should not be consuming alcohol on our vessel.

Terms & Conditions of Charter

Food and Beverage

- ✓ The menu selections and menu prices indicated in this portfolio for food and beverage are current at the time of printing in January 2011. They may change up to one month prior to your function date.
- ✓ Specific menu consultations can be arranged but we ask they are also finalized 30 days prior to your charter. Vegetarian options are available on all menus.
- ✓ BYO is not available on "On the Edge". In the rare circumstance where BYO is allowed, this must be pre-arranged through your wedding consultant 30 days prior and additional fees will apply.
- ✓ In accordance with the Responsible Service of Alcohol requirements, our staff may refuse alcohol service to persons they believe are intoxicated or have no proof of age.
- ✓ Beverages included on the Sunset Cruise may alter but will be of similar quality.

Boarding & Departure Times

- ✓ All departures will be from the Cruise Indigo jetty located on Front Street opposite the Ice Cream Parlor. Please allow 15 minutes for boarding.
- ✓ On the Edge will endeavor to depart at the agreed departure time. If you or your guests are late we generally will be required to return to the harbour at the scheduled agreed time. No extra time will be allocated due to lateness on behalf of the guests/bridal party unless prior arrangements have been made with Cruise Indigo Operations.

Additional Cruising or Dock Time

- ✓ We ask that additional cruising time or dock time be pre-arranged.
- ✓ Additional cruising time is only available as an 'add on' to a charter.
- ✓ You will have 15 minutes at the dock once the boat returns to the harbor in addition to the cruising time for disembarking. If the group wish to remain on the boat at the dock for longer than this time an additional fee will be charged. We are not permitted longer than one hour as per our liquor license.

Damage & Theft

- ✓ The company spends a great deal of time and money to ensure that we exceed your expectations with the quality of the vessel. If the boat and/or its fixtures/appliances are lost or damaged in any way as a result of the actions of your guests then you will be liable to cover the cost of their repair/replacement of the loss/damage.

Our Agreement

- ✓ Your agreement is with Denison Star Pty Ltd trading as Cruise Indigo.
- ✓ Once you have made your booking and paid a deposit, the cost of the charter portion of your booking will normally not be subject to any change. However we reserve the right to amend charges relating to any increases in GST, Government and Reef Taxes as applicable.
- ✓ A contract exists as soon as the deposit is paid and by making that payment you will be deemed to have accepted our quotation invoice and agree to be bound by our booking conditions.

Deposit

- ✓ A non refundable deposit of \$500.00 is required to secure the booking and can be paid by cash, credit card or direct deposit. Visa & Mastercard payments attract a 1.5 % processing fee with AMEX payments attracting a 3% fee. Diners card are not accepted.

Payment Policy

- ✓ Once your deposit has been paid, your booking is confirmed. We ask that 100% of the charter fee is paid 30 days prior to the charter date.
- ✓ All food specifications are to be finalized and paid for 30 days prior to the charter date. If you do not specify your choice by this requested timing, we reserve the right to choose your menu and charge accordingly.

Passenger Numbers

- ✓ An estimate of passenger numbers must be provided upon the initial booking – this is to ensure that the appropriate cruise and food options have been selected. If the numbers vary greatly, this may affect the type of cruise and food options available to you and may vary from what was originally discussed.
- ✓ We ask final passenger numbers be confirmed 14 days prior to the charter. If your numbers are greater than confirmed, additional costs will apply for catering, staff and reef tax.

Cancellation Policy

- ✓ You may cancel your arrangements at any time however charges will apply as follows:
Less than 30 days & more than 14 days prior to the charter 50% of charter fee
Less than 14 days but more than 7 days prior to the charter 75% of the charter fee
Within 7 days of the charter 100% of the charter fee and catering costs

Indemnity

- ✓ The charterer must accept responsibility for the proper conduct of themselves and any members of their party. We reserve the right to remove any guest from the vessel. Upon such termination our responsibility for your charter ceases and we shall not be liable for any extra costs or liabilities incurred by you.

Agreement

- ✓ By paying a deposit you agree to all the above terms and conditions of charter
