Her large deck area provides the perfect platform to enjoy a Whitsunday Sunset.

### Included in your cruise:

### Commonly asked questions:

- **What to wear** – we ask for flat soled shoes, thongs are no problems. Ladies please do not wear high heeled shoes. A jacket is recommended for the cooler months.
- **Days & times of operation?** – please check when booking as these depend on the season of the year.
- **What about cover?** – the vessel has a roof that covers a large portion of the deck area.
- **Is it calm?** – as we operate within close proximity to Hamilton Island we will always provide calm sailing conditions regardless of the wind strength.
- **Is this a cruise for all ages?** – being a sailing cat this vessel is generally very stable. Due to the tranquil nature of this cruise however we do not recommend this tour for children under the age of 8 years of age.
