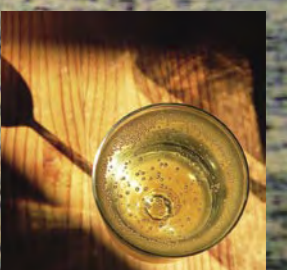
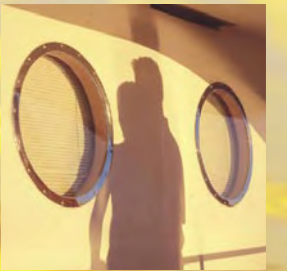


The Sunset and Seafood Cruise combines traditional cruising amongst some of the most beautiful island scenery in the world with a freshly prepared on-board seafood smorgasbord.

As an alternate to our Cruise & Dine, this cruise caters for a wider range of ages and offers a family package rate, and of course the focus of the food is absolutely fresh seafood. Total duration of the cruise is approximately three hours all cruising within the sheltered waters surrounding Hamilton Island.

Upon boarding we welcome you with a complimentary cocktail (non-alcoholic for the under 18's of course) and a light nibbles platter. We then cruise for around one hour enjoying the sunset and commence seating for dinner in our air-conditioned dining room on the lower deck. Seating arrangements are booth style for up to four so generally you will be seated with other guests throughout dinner.

The smorgasbord includes a variety of absolutely fresh seafood and non-seafood items including natural oysters (freshly shucked on board by our chefs daily), chilled Gold Coast Prawns, fresh fish baked on board, roast beef and a variety of fresh salads and roast vegetables. We aim to cater for all different tastes and styles even if you are not a seafood eater. A complimentary bottle of wine is also included per adult couple. We also have a special alternate menu for the children 12 and under. The current menu will be available at our office due to seasonal variations.



Included in your evening with us

- Approximately three hours cruising on the magnificent Denison Star within the sheltered waters surrounding Hamilton Island.
 - Nibbles platter and welcome daiquiri upon arrival (non-alcoholic for the minors of course)
 - Informative commentary from your skipper on the Whitsunday Islands and surrounds.
 - A complimentary bottle of wine per adult couple and glass of softdrink for the under 18's.
- A smorgasbord choice of seafood and non-seafood served in the air-conditioned dining room. A special under 12's menu is also available
 - Dessert is also included comprising of seasonal fruits and petite ice cream cones served on the top deck on your return cruise to Hamilton Island.
 - Brewed coffee or a selection of tea's also available after dinner.

Commonly asked questions:

- **What about seating for dinner?** - the dining room on the lower deck is shared booth seating and commonly you will be seated with other guests. We find this a great social environment to meet people while on holidays. If you would like a guaranteed table for two on this cruise please see upgrade options below.
- **What do I wear?** - we encourage smart casual and a jacket in the winter months may be required. Ladies please do not wear high heeled shoes as they damage our Huon Pine decks.
- **What about drinks?** - we have full bar facilities and a selection of fine wines for purchase.
- **What about the weather?** - due to the many islands and inlets close to Hamilton Island we will always stop for dinner at a calm, secluded spot - guaranteed! The vessel is fully enclosed so even when raining, it does not stop the operations of this cruise.
- **Where do we go?** - generally we visit the largest and most protected harbour in the Whitsundays called Cid Harbour. If the weather is very windy we also have options very close to Hamilton Island.
- **Days and times of operation?** - Days of operation and time of departure are dependant on the time of year. These will be confirmed upon booking

Age guidelines? – the minimum age limit for this cruise is 6 yrs. The operations of the vessel does not allow for use of high chairs.

Upgrade Options

Private Table for Two - \$165 pp plus \$3 Reef Levy pp

In the dining room on the lower deck most tables are set for four people dining at the one table and most guests are happy to socialise whilst having dinner. Should you wish to have your own table guaranteed, this is the option for you. We have available three tables located in the Cocktail Lounge on the upper deck that are specifically for two. We also offer table service to the private table diners, with your cold and hot seafood served platter style to your table to share, in addition to the complimentary bottle of wine per couple.

Larger Group Private Table - \$150 pp plus \$3 Reef Levy pp

As our tables in the dining room generally seat a maximum of six people we can seat a group of up to 10 people in the cocktail lounge at one table. Normal cruise inclusions apply but a great way to have your group altogether.
