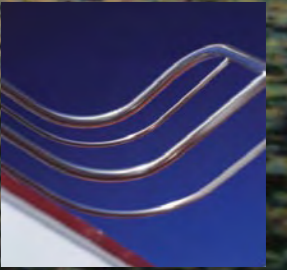
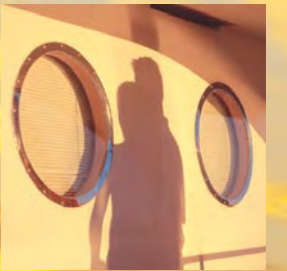


The Sunset and Seafood Cruise on the Denison Star, combines traditional style boating with a scrumptious seafood smorgasbord, whilst cruising amongst some of the most beautiful Island and water scenery in the world.

As an alternate to our Cruise and Dine, this cruise is our family friendly option catering for all ages from six years and above. Total duration of the evening is approximately three hours with all cruising within the sheltered waters surrounding Hamilton Island.

Upon boarding we welcome you with a cocktail (non-alcoholic for the under 18's) and a light nibbles platter. After cruising for approximately 45 minutes the smorgasbord commences in the air-conditioned dining room on the lower deck of the vessel. Seating arrangements are booth style for up to four so you will occasionally be seated with other guests for dinner.

The smorgasbord includes a variety of seafood and non-seafood items including natural oysters, chilled prawns, fresh fish, crab, roast beef, a variety of fresh salads and vegetables. Guaranteed to cater for all different tastes and styles. The current menu will be available at our office due to seasonal variations.



Included in your evening

- Nibbles platter and welcome daiquiri on arrival (non alcoholic available for the minors)
- Informative commentary of the Whitsunday Islands and approximately three hours cruising on the Denison Star within the sheltered waters surrounding Hamilton Island.
- Seafood smorgasbord served in the air-conditioned restaurant area on the lower deck of the vessel. Contact our office for the current menu of the night.
- Dessert served platter style including seasonal fruits and petite individual ice cream cones.
- Brewed coffee or a selection of tea's are also included. Softdrink is also included all night for the big and little kids.

Commonly asked questions:

- **What about seating for dinner?**- the dining room on the lower deck is shared booth seating and commonly you will be seated with other guests. We find this a great social environment to meet people while on holidays. If you would like a guaranteed table for two on this cruise please see upgrade options below.
 - **What do I wear?** - We encourage guests to wear smart casual with some warmer clothing in the winter months. The dining room of the vessel is air-conditioned for comfort while eating in the summer months. Ladies, please do not wear high heeled shoes to look after our Huon Pine decks!
 - **What about drinks?** - we have full bar facilities and a selection of fine wines for purchase. Softdrink is provided all cruise for all guests.
 - **Is it always calm?** - due to the many islands and inlets close to Hamilton Island we will always stop for dinner at a calm, secluded spot - guaranteed! The vessel is fully enclosed so even when raining, it does not stop the operations of this cruise.
 - **Where do we go?** - generally we visit the largest and most protected harbour in the Whitsundays called Cid Harbour. If the weather is very windy we also have options very close to Hamilton Island.
 - **Days and times of operation?** - Days of operation and time of departure are dependant on the time of year. These will be confirmed upon booking
- Age guidelines?** – the minimum age limit for this cruise is 6 yrs. The operations of the vessel does not allow for use of high chairs. Baby sitting can be arranged through the Clown Fish Club on Island.

Conditions of travel: As we cater for smaller passenger numbers we have found it necessary to implement the following conditions of travel when booking a cruise with us: (i) If you cancel on the day of the cruise before 2pm - no charge.
